

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q. What time do the gates open?

A. Friday, Nov. 11 gates open at 5 pm. Saturday, Nov.12 and Sunday, Nov. 13 gates open at 9 am.

Q. Is parking free and are there shuttles?

A. General admission parking is free and there are complimentary shuttles from the parking lot to the gates. Premium parking is also available but can only be purchased online and in advance.

Q. Is there ADA parking?

A. Yes, please clearly display ADA placard in the front dash of the vehicle.

Q. When does the show begin?

A. Opening Ceremony begins at approximately 11:30 am. and the aerobatic portion of the airshow will start following the ceremony.

Q. Where do I enter?

A. There are two drive-in gates off Monterey Road. Please follow directions and guidance from Martin County Sheriff's Office and all traffic and parking volunteers.

Q. Will my bags be checked before entering the airshow?

A. People and personal items may be subject to searches and ALL bags will be checked.

Q. Are large strollers/wagons/wheelchairs permitted?

A. Yes strollers, double strollers, and wagons are permitted. The shuttle buses will not be wheelchair accessible.

Q. Can I bring my own shade canopy or beach umbrella?

A. No, for the safety of attendees and aircraft large umbrellas are not permitted.

Q. What methods of payment are available at the show?

A. Cash and credits cards are accepted. Please remember to bring CASH if you plan to shop at our vendors. ATMs will be available but long lines are to be expected.

Q. Will smoking be allowed?

A. NO SMOKING is allowed at the airshow in any location—and is strictly prohibited around aircraft.

Q. What items are prohibited from the airshow?

A. The following items are prohibited:

- Coolers, except for lifesaving medicine or formula for infants
- Alcohol and all other beverages
- Food
- Drones
- Bikes
- Scooters
- Skateboards
- In-line skates & roller skates
- Pets (except official service animals)

- Balloons
- Large, golf or beach umbrellas
- Po-up tents
- All fire arms

Q. Can I bring a chair, blanket and or umbrella?

A. Chairs, blankets, and small inspectable personal comfort items will be permitted. Small umbrellas are fine to bring in the event of rain (the small ones that fit in a purse), but large golf umbrellas or shade umbrellas are banned as they may block the view of spectators behind you.

Q. Are large cameras, lenses, bags and tripods allowed, or cell phones?

A. Yes. There are no security restrictions on these items. However, they will be thoroughly checked at the bag check area before entering the airshow gate. I

Q. I have small children. Can I bring a stroller, diaper bag, or a change of clothes?

A. Yes. Stroller and diaper bags will be hand-searched at the security checkpoint. Also please consider bringing hearing protection for small children.

Q. Can I bring food or a cooler of beverages?

A. No food or beverages or coolers are permitted. Exception: small compact cooler to transport live-saving medicine or for the needs of a small child or infant. All items are subject to approval by security personnel and are hand-searched at security checkpoints.

Q. Will there be any food or souvenirs available?

A. Yes. There will be concessions at the airshow for food, drinks, and souvenirs.

Q. Can I leave and re-enter the airshow?

A. Yes. You may leave and re-enter as many times as needed with a hand stamp. Please remember to have your hand stamped prior to leaving the show, and note you may be subject to bag checks again upon return.

Q. Is tailgating allowed, or can I bring my camper or RV?

A. No.

Q. Are alcoholic beverages allowed?

A. You can purchase them at concessions, but you cannot bring them onto base.

Q. Do I need a military ID?

A. Only if you purchased a veteran ticket.

Q. Will restroom facilities be easily accessible?

A. Yes. Portable restrooms will be located throughout the airshow.

Q. Can I take pictures or get autographs?

A. Yes. Many of the performers make themselves available for autographs and pictures during the show.

Q. Will it be necessary to have hearing protection?

A. Due to the nature of the event, it is highly encouraged you bring hearing protection – especially for children. There will be several aircraft taking off, landing, and performing, which will be extremely loud.

Q. Will there be shade?

A. There are limited areas of shade area/tents available.

Q. What happens if it rains?

A. In the event of rain, some flying demonstrations may be delayed. However, unless the weather poses a serious threat to the safety of the visitors and participants, the show will proceed as scheduled with some modifications. In the event of an airshow cancellation, announcements will be coordinated with local news agencies as well as on our airshow social media pages.

Q. What type of medical services will be available?

A. First aid only will be provided such as treatment for mild dehydration, treatment for minor cuts and bruises, and application of emergency medications (ex. Epi-pens). Medical personnel will stabilize and coordinate transportation to higher level care for all other injuries/illnesses as determined by a medical professional.

Q. Is there a preferred seating area?

A. Yes, this year there is an option for paid seating near show center. Information can be found at www.stuartairshow.com/tickets

Q. What children's activities are available?

A. There will be a free kid's zone that features bouncy castles and activities this area is sponsored by the YMCA. And there is another area by Mobile Mountain with more interactive physical activities.

Q. I'm a food vendor, is there an opportunity to participate?

A. A master concessionaire has been selected and no other food or merchandise vendors are being accepted.
